


WRITING THE NEWS

HEADLINE


This outlines what your article is about. The words you use here will let you know the tone of the article.

FIRST SECTION




The first paragraph extends on the headline and answers the 5 Ws (who, what, where, when and why). Additional paragraphs in this section will provide further information for the reader.

SECOND SECTION




This section will go into more detail while backing up the previous section's information. It is in this section that you will include witness statements or quotes.

FINAL SECTION



This section will explain what is going to happen next. It is an opportunity for the writer to include links or phone numbers relevant to the news story or an opportunity for a call to action if necessary.

IMAGES & CAPTIONS



Think about the images you might use for your story, and also the captions you may use and who will be credited for the images,.
